Founded in 1862 by Mr. Ebenezer Morley, the first FA Secretary, Barnes Football Club is 6th oldest club in England and as such, one of the oldest clubs in the world! As one of the founding members of the FA and a home of FA Rules, Barnes FC was competing in the first 14 consecutive FA Cups in the 19th Century.

With support from Sport England, local community sponsors and led by grandchildren of Mr. Kilsby, who was the chair and the longest servant to the club from 1926- 1972, Barnes FC is reviving the history and its importance to the game. The manager is UEFA B qualified (FA Level 3) and has a broad experience working with people of all ages and abilities.
